The Brookline Community Church is having a special meeting on Sunday, November 17th at 11:30 am to present the new Monetary Expenditure Policy, adopted by the Cabinet on September 8, and to get an update from the Trustees on the Church Window Replacement project. All church members are invited to participate in the discussion, decision process, and vote on the expenditure for the windows. This discussion and vote are part of the church's ongoing discernment of God's call and mission and require a quorum of 18 people to transact this business.
