Then Paul stood in front of the Areopagus and said, "Athenians, I see how Extremely religious you are in every way. Emergency services come quickly, but it can be hard finding the right house if the numbers aren't clear and visible from at least 50' away. So take a fresh look at how easy it is to find your home, especially for someone hurrying to help!

B – S.A.F.E.: Brookline - Special Assistance for Emergencies

If you have special accommodation needs or require special assistance during a possible or actual emergency within the town, such as an extended power outage or undrivable road conditions, the information would be helpful to local responders.
